

Escambia County Voters Want You to Mask Up – Period!

August 2, 2020

For Immediate Release:

On August 2, the Inweekly/Political Matrix found, in overwhelming fashion, the desire of Escambia County voters to mask up and, additionally, want a mandate for this measure. In a study of 823 voters we see 79.6% think masks help prevent the spread of Covid-19. We found 83.8% wear their masks either most of the time or all of the time. We see that 77.9% think masks should be mandated by employees and visitors when they are located in government building. Additionally, 40.6% think law enforcement should enforce the compliance of a face mask mandate and 50.6% think that fines should be imposed on those who do not comply with the face mask mandates. We also see, of those that are working, just over 85% have employers making them wear face masks at work either some of the time, most of the time or always. Additionally, we see that 81.8% think it is either important or very important for employees of a restaurant to wear a mask. And finally, we see that 80.8% think it is either important or very important for employees of convenient stores, grocery stores or other retail establishment to wear a mask.

These numbers are very high and, in a reality, leave little room for debate. On the immediate 2 pages is the topline data for each of 8 questions presented to the respondent. On the following pages are the cross tabulations to include age, gender, county district and party affiliation.

METHODOLOGY:

The cross tabs for this study are party, age, gender, and county commissioner districts. The persons sampled were Escambia County likely voters with a voting score of 85% for the general election cycles. The voters called were those only with landlines and were called using an Interactive Voice Response (IVR) system and were called during the hours of 4PM to 8PM on August 2, 2020. The Margin of Error for this study is +/- 4.5% with a confidence level of 95%. Please see details on the following pages.
